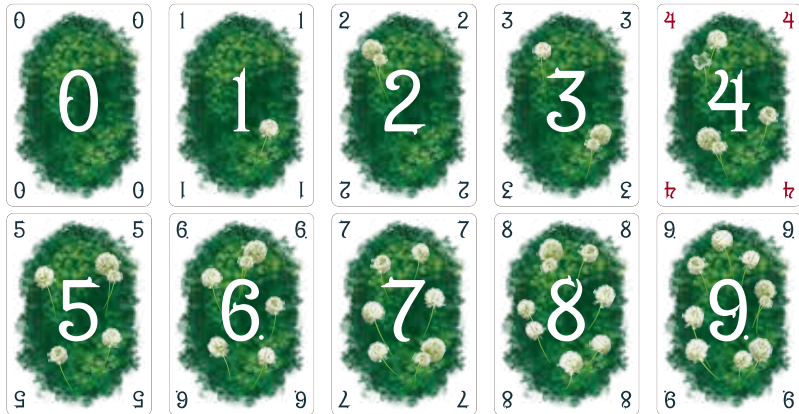




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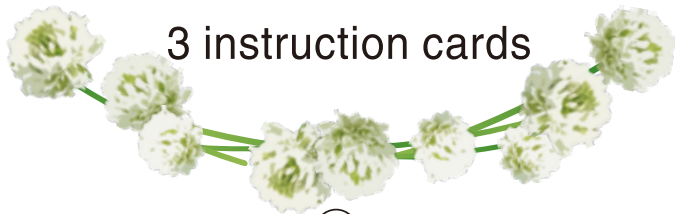


20 cards

Back is yellow-green/blue-green

One card numbered 0 to 9 (10 card types)
for each color

3 instruction cards

Pick white clovers
to make a garland

Use as many flowers as you can
Make your garland more splendid than hers
Make your garland bigger than hers

Oh, I don't have enough flowers!
I want more flowers...

I'll take some from her!
Whose bouquet is the biggest?

Oh, but wait...
Watch out for the four-leaved clover
The unthinkable will happen

Now then...
Pick white clovers
to make a garland

Game Preparation

Each player receives ten cards numbered 0 to 9 with the same color on the back (blue-green or yellow-green). Hold the cards facing yourself so the others can't see the numbers.



How to Play

- ① The players draw one card each from each other's hand at the same time and check the number.
- ② Next, the players choose a card of any number from their own hand, combine it with the card they drew from their opponent, and reveal their combination at the same time.
- ② The players add up the numbers on the cards for each combination played, and whoever has the higher number wins that round.

※ **Players must combine their card with the card they drew from their opponent during step ①.**

Players cannot add cards to their hand.

※ If the sum of the numbers on both cards is the same, that round is a tie.

③

- ④ The winner places both players' cards revealed played during that round face down before themselves in a bouquet, marking them the winner of that round. For ties, each player takes only the cards they played and places them before themselves.
- ⑤ Repeat steps ① to ④ for five rounds, until both players run out of cards.



The **Four** Leaf Clover

The **4** card features an illustration of a **four**-leaf clover and has special rules.

If a **4** card appears in a combination played by either player, **the winner of that round is the player with the lowest sum.**

※ **When two 4 cards are played**

When both players play a **4** card, or if a player plays the **4** card drawn from their opponent together with the **4** card in their own hand, **that round is a tie, regardless of the sum of the cards.**

Ending the Game

The game ends when players have played five rounds of steps ① to ④ and no longer have any cards to play.

The player who has won the most rounds out of the five rounds is the winner of the game.

Also, even when players still have cards, if one player has already won three rounds, that player is the winner, and the rest of the game will not be played.

If the number of times each player has won a round is a tie, then the game is a tie.

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
