

# 2nd Best!

A strategy game where you block your  
your opponent's best hand.

## Conditions to win

(Players who meet any of the below conditions win.)

- ★ Your piece is the piece on the top of 4 continuous cells.
- ★ You have 3 pieces overlapped in a single cell.
- ★ The opponent cannot move the piece.

## How to play

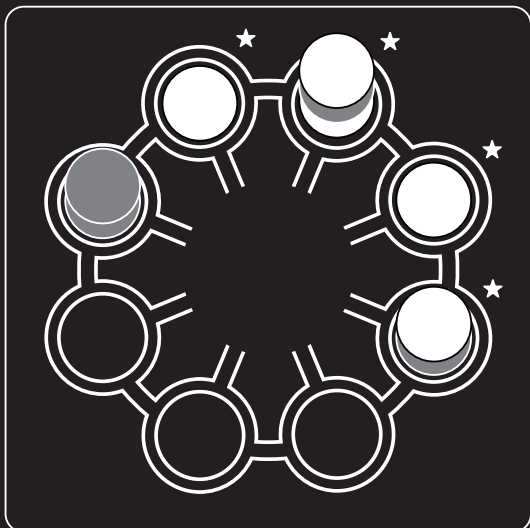
- Alternately place your pieces in cells of your choice.  
(Each piece can be stacked up to three at a time in any given cell)
- If you are out of pieces, you can move the piece of yours that is at the highest position in the board to a cell directly next to or across from where it is currently.  
(You can only move it to a cell with up to 2 other pieces for a total of 3 pieces in the cell total.)
- You can call, "2nd Best!" to a given hand of your opponent up to once per turn.
- The opponent who was called out must choose a different hand. It must be re-selected.
- After receiving a "2nd Best!" declaration, the player can place a piece to finish the round or if there is no "2nd Best!" declaration made, another player gets a turn to go.

## Special cases

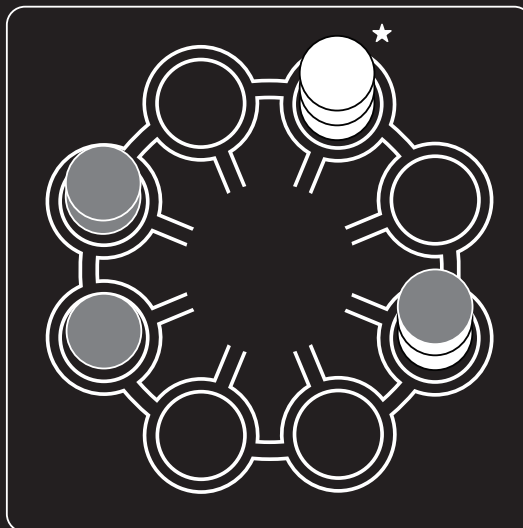
- If two opposing players each meet the winning requirements, the player who made the move last wins.



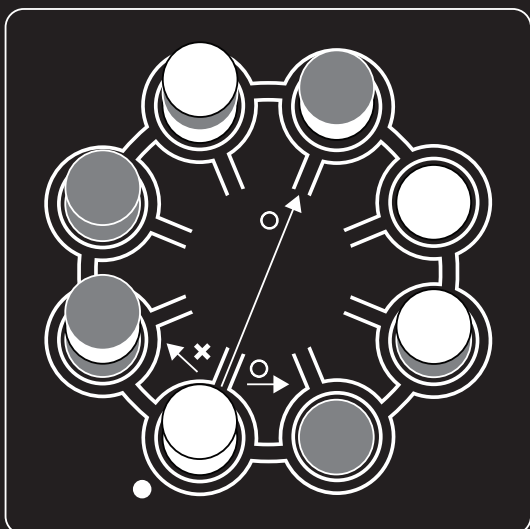
★ If your piece is the top piece after 4 cells are lined up.



★ You have 3 pieces overlapped in a single cell.



● Examples of moving to the adjacent or opposing cell.



※"2nd Best!" can only be declared one time during a player's turn, but it can be declared an unlimited number of times in a single game round.

※"2nd Best!" can be declared on the same piece more than once after it has moved.

It is possible, even after it has been declared. Even if "2nd Best!" is declared against you, you can still win by moving your piece to another cell.

※You cannot move to the cell left of you because there are already 3 pieces in that cell.

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
